The school district will be reprogramming their digital radios over the holiday break.

AGENDA ITEM #3 – TRAINING AND EXERCISES

Meetings have been held with the fire department, police department, Cetronia EMS, and Parkland School District concerning an active shooter training to be held on August 9, 2023 at the Springhouse Middle School. Monthly meeting will be held about the training starting in January 2023. A6A will be in touch with each agency regarding the training.

The County needs role players for an active shooter class on January 9 -11, 2023 at DeSales University.

AGENDA ITEM #4 – NIXLE UPDATE

The system is operational. Sign-up notices have been posted in the Township building and on the Township website. Information will be sent to residents in their first quarter 2023 sewer bills.

Fire departments will be automatically dispatched on EMS calls when the EMS system enters snow mode.

The County is looking to see if Cetronia Ambulance can be added to fill the remaining open slots in WEB EOC.

The Township thanked Woodlawn for assisting in cleaning streets after two recent Aqua PA watermain leaks.

The Cetronia Ambulance year-to-date statistics are as follows.

Total responses – 14,910 Calls in SWT – 3722 Calls in Whitehall Township – 3836 Calls in Upper Macungie Township – 2900 Average response time – 9 minutes, 5 seconds SWT calls handled by mutual aid – 74 Whitehall Township calls handled by mutual aid – 200 Mutual aid calls into Allentown – 821 Mutual aid calls into Lower Macungie/Macungie Borough – 284

Michael LaPearl is the new director of Education. Eight new EMT's are expected to graduate at the end of January 2023. Four individuals have signed up for the next EMT class scheduled to start in March 2023.

The pay rate for paratransit drivers was recently increased to \$15.25/hour, resulting in sixteen new applications for employment.

The blanket insurance policy for the Township covers its CERT emergency management volunteers.
